

**A RESOLUTION OF THE SALUDA COUNTY REPUBLICAN PARTY IN STRONG SUPPORT OF THE SAVE AMERICA ACT (H.R. 7296 / S. 3752)**

**WHEREAS**, free and fair elections, conducted with transparent and trustworthy procedures, are essential to the legitimacy of the United States and to the consent of the governed; and

**WHEREAS**, only citizens of the United States are legally eligible to vote in federal elections, yet existing federal law and state practices do not uniformly require documentary proof of citizenship to register, creating vulnerabilities that can be exploited and undermining public confidence in election results;

**WHEREAS**, the SAVE America Act (H.R. 7296 / S. 3752) would amend the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 to require states to obtain and verify documentary proof of United States citizenship before adding an applicant to the voter rolls for federal elections, and would direct the Election Assistance Commission to issue implementation guidance on these requirements;

**WHEREAS**, the SAVE America Act further requires eligible photo identification for voting in federal elections and provides mechanisms for states to compare their voter rolls with federal immigration and naturalization records to help ensure that only citizens remain registered, thereby strengthening both voter registration integrity and in-person voting security;

**WHEREAS**, these reforms reflect the common-sense expectation of the people of Saluda County and the State of South Carolina that only American citizens should choose America's leaders, and they seek to restore confidence in elections without preventing any eligible citizen from registering or casting a lawful ballot;

**WHEREAS**, opponents of the SAVE America Act have attacked the bill precisely because it is likely to be effective in tightening voter registration, improving list maintenance, and requiring meaningful proof of citizenship, but their criticisms do not outweigh the compelling national interest in protecting the franchise of lawful American voters;

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Saluda County Republican Party strongly supports The SAVE America Act (H.R. 7296 / S. 3752) as a vital measure to safeguard American voter eligibility, secure our federal elections, and restore public trust in the electoral process; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Saluda County Republican Party urges all Members of Congress representing the State of South Carolina to cosponsor, advance, and vote for prompt passage of the SAVE America Act, and calls upon the leadership of both the United States House of Representatives and the United States Senate to bring this legislation swiftly to the floor for debate and a recorded vote; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that copies of this resolution be transmitted to President Donald J. Trump, President of the United States; to the South Carolina Congressional Delegation; and to the appropriate committees of jurisdiction, together with a request that they act decisively to secure our elections by enacting the SAVE America Act into law.
